General information about the tournament

- Playing hall** Fritz-Henßler-Haus, Haus der Jugend, Geschwister-Scholl-Str. 33, 44135 Dortmund
The playing hall is wheelchair accessible
- Participants** 10 young players (under 20 years, Elo 2000-2350) from Dortmund, NRW and foreign countries
- Mode** Round robin with 9 rounds
- Time limit** 90 minutes/40 moves + 30 minutes/rest + 30 seconds/move
30 minutes waiting period, no draw-agreements before move 30
- Schedule** Saturday, July 9 first round, Sunday, July 17 last round and following ceremony
Daily start of rounds 11am, only one round per day
- GM-Tournament** Free access to the 450 metres away playing hall of the GM-tournament with live-commentary in German at Orchesterzentrum (Brückstr. 47) during the Dortmund Sparkassen Chess-Meeting. (www.sparkassen-chess-meeting.de)
Start of round in GM-tournament 3pm
- Open** In the playing hall of the Helmut-Kohls-Turnier there is the Sparkassen-Open 2015 including 3 tournaments. (www.scm-open.de)
- Entry fee** For the Helmut-Kohls-Turnier there is no entry fee to pay
- Prizes** 1st place 200 € 2nd place 150 € 3rd place 110 € 4th place 80 € 5th place 60 €
- Same score** 1. Sonneborn-Berger System 2. Direct encounter, 3. Number of games played with black pieces, 4. Number of games won, 5. draw lots. Prized will not be shared
- Accommodation** The accommodation is subsidized
- Mobiles etc.** In accordance with the current FIDE rules the carrying of mobile phones or other electronic devices on the body is prohibited. The switched off devices can also be carried in bags, jackets etc.
Additional all participants have to sign the sanctioning power of the DSB before the tournament.
- Chess books** Chess book sale with a varied selection
- Catering** Food and drinks are offered for low prices in the analysis area. Participants will get vouchers for snacks and drinks.
