Playing hall	Fritz-Henßler-Haus, Haus der Jugend, Geschwister-Scholl-Str. 33, 44135 Dortmund The playing hall is wheelchair accessible
Participants	10 young players (under 20 years, Elo 2000-2350) from Dortmund, NRW and foreign countries
Mode	Round robin with 9 rounds
Time limit	90 minutes/40 moves + 30 minutes/rest + 30 seconds/move 30 minutes waiting period, no draw-agreements before move 30
Schedule	Saturday, July 9 first round, sunday, July 17 last round and following ceremony Daily start of rounds 11am, only one round per day
GM-Tournament	Free access to the 450 metres away playing hall of the GM-torunament with live-commentary in German at Orchesterzentrum (Brückstr. 47) during the Dortmund Sparkassen Chess-Meeting. (www.sparkassen-chess-meeting.de) Start of round in GM-tournatment 3pm
Open	In the playing hall of the Helmut-Kohls-Turnier there is the Sparkassen-Open 2015 including 3 torunaments. (www.scm-open.de)
Entry fee	For the Helmut-Kohls-Turnier there is no entry fee to pay
